

Every Year of Schooling Raises Earnings 8-10%




A Simple Model









An Analysis of COVID-19 Student Learning Loss

Implications

Differentiated Effects



Level of education	Annual loss	Lifetime loss
Primary	\$272	\$7,000
Secondary	\$363	\$9,000
Tertiary	\$725	\$18,000

COVID-19 Cost of School Closures



\$15-\$17 trillion loss in lifetime earnings 12-18% of current year GDP over lifetime 0.8% annual reduction in GDP
